Proposal for Core Community Events

Sunday 3 June

10.00 - 10.25 Grand Parade to Rectory Garden

Assembly Points: Goring: Cleeve Rd. Streatley: St Mary's Church.
All local organisations welcome and encouraged to join in.

10.30 - 11.30 'Songs of Praise'

Venue - Rectory Garden. Service of Thanksgiving (all churches together)
(Followed by brief ceremony to 'top out' Goring's new Village Sign with 'EIIR 2012').

12.00 - 15.00 'The Big Jubilee Lunch' Street Party

Venue - Goring High St (corner of Cleeve Rd - corner of Thames Rd.)
BYO lunch & tables/chairs. Roving musicians & street entertainers
(Road closure to be applied for between 10.00 -17.00
with 2-way diversion via Cleeve Rd, Glebe Ride & Thames Rd).

19.00 - 22.00 Jubilee Concert

Venue - Gardiner Field, Cleeve Road.
BYO picnic/dinner, tables & chairs. (Royal and/or 50s Fancy Dress?)
Music, dance & theatre - The best of our local talent.

Monday 4 June

11.00 - 13.00 Water Pageant & Flotilla 'Sail Past'

Venue - River & Towpath (Downstream of Lock between Bridge - Ferry Lane)
Dressed boats sail past, followed by fun races (eg homemade rafts & canoes etc)

13.30 - 16.30 Junior Olympics & Jubilee Fair

Venue - The Ferry House Island Field (behind hedge of towpath)

Sports day events for children and the whole family. Stalls, music & entertainment.

22.15 - 23.30 Jubilee Beacon, Torchlight Procession & 'Sing Song Finale'

Viewpoints: (Various TBA) - Watch lighting of 'flaming' EIIR' and/or bonfire Beacon
on Lardon Chase (Joining 2,012 others to be lit at the same moment across the UK).
Followed by lighting of wax torches at 22.45 at various viewpoints.
Various processions from viewpoints, merging at the Sing Song venue.
